**Through the New Testament in 2018:** Read Mark 8-12

Monday | **1 Corinthians 1:9-11**

What does Paul say the gospel is? Why is the resurrection of Jesus so important? What difference did grace make in Paul's story? How about in your story?

Tuesday | **Philippians 3:1-12**

In some ways Paul had a great past—so why was he so dismissive of it? Why did his life in Christ excite him so much more? What about your faith life gets you most excited?

Wednesday | **Ephesians 2:1-10**

What was your life like before you met Christ? How has he changed you? How is he changing you right now? What is one reason Paul gives for God choosing to save us?

Thursday | **Ephesians 3:7-13**

What does it mean to be a servant of the gospel? How does grace help us in sharing our faith?

Friday | **1 Timothy 1:12-17**

How does God view our past? How does being honest about our stories help us share our faith with others?

Sunday preview | **Acts 16**
