**Paul had a heart for the lost—just like Jesus! The following passages are from the life of Jesus.**

**Through the New Testament in 2018:** Read Mark 13-Luke 1

Monday | **Matthew 9:27-38**

What do you see when you see people? Do you see them as harassed and helpless? What are some ways that you can show compassion and concern?

Tuesday | **John 4:1-38**

Why was the Samaritan woman surprised? Why were the disciples surprised? How far out of your comfort zone are you willing to go to share your faith?

Wednesday | **Mark 2:1-17**

Why was Jesus criticized? How do you feel about Christ-followers who hang out with people who don't know Jesus? How can you have more contact with people who need Christ?

Thursday | **Luke 8:26-39**

Why did Jesus cross the lake? To how many people did He minister? Do you think this person was a good prospect to hear the gospel?

Friday | **John 3:1-21**

Why do you think this meeting took place at night? How might this man's story contrast to the Samaritan woman (Tues) and demoniac (Thurs)? With what types of people should we look to share our faith?

Sunday preview | **1 Corinthians 9:19-22**

What drove Paul to make some of the decisions he made? How does your passion to reach the lost affect your decisions? And which ones?
