**As Christ-followers we look forward to the future, especially to the second coming of Christ. This week's passages focus on what our future will be like.**

**Through the New Testament in 2018:** John 8-12

Monday | **2 Corinthians 5:1-10**

What is it that causes us to groan? What does it mean to be at home with the Lord? Why do you think the truth of verse 7 is included in this passage? What do you think it will be like to appear before Jesus?

Tuesday | **Titus 2:11-15**

What reasons are given for us to live self-controlled and godly lives? How does looking forward to Christ's return help us to live as we should today?

Wednesday | **1 Thessalonians 4:13-18**

What does it mean to grieve, but not as those who have no hope? How does the coming of Christ bring hope in the face of loss? How much do you look forward to being with the Lord forever?

Thursday | **Revelation 21:1-5**

What will be the greatest feature of the new heaven and new earth? Why does God want to dwell with us? What will eternity look like?

Friday | **Revelation 22:12-22**

What promise does Jesus make? What is John's response? How anxious are you for the return of Jesus?

Sunday preview | **1 John 5:14-17**

When you pray, how confident do you feel that God will hear you? That He will answer you? How can we pray “according to His will?”
