Tuesday | **Matthew 11:2-11**

What did Jesus have to say about the Kingdom? How is the Kingdom advancing today? How are you a part of its advancing? What is it that makes a person great in the Kingdom?

Wednesday | **Luke 17:17-25**

So has the Kingdom of God already come, or is it still to come, or both? How can your experience the Kingdom now and yet still look forward to it?

Thursday | **Matthew 6:28-34**

What does it mean to seek God's Kingdom first? Why does doing so make sense? How is the Kingdom of God different from this kingdom we call Earth?

Friday | **John 18:33-37**

How is Jesus' Kingdom not of this world? What are some of the things of this world that we make more important than we should?

Sunday preview | **Mark 14:32-42**

How often do you take the time to evaluate whether or not your prayer requests line up with God's desires? Why is this important?
