Monday | **Matthew 5:13-16**

What did Jesus mean when He called His followers salt? How can a Christian lose his or her saltiness? How might a believer hide his or her light? How can you be salt and light to people in your life?

Tuesday | **Matthew 5:17-20**

What warning was given to those who would encourage disregard for the Word of God? Why is it difficult for us to practice what we preach? When and how can you consult the Bible for guidance this week?

Wednesday | **Matthew 5:21-26**

Why did Jesus zero in on the emotions behind our violent actions? Why is it necessary to get things right with people before we come to worship God? What relational conflicts do you need to address?

Thursday | **Matthew 5:27-32**

Why are moral choices important? What three steps can you take this week to protect your marriage from affairs? What can you do this week to strengthen your marriage?

Friday | **Matthew 5:33-42**

How should we respond when people try to get us to make promises or extra assurances? What steps can you take this week to become known as a person who keeps his or her word?

Sunday preview | **Matthew 13:1-23**

How do stories and illustrations help us to understand more clearly the message of the Bible? What circumstances have a tendency to scorch your faith and cause it to wither?
